Minimum Requirements:

- Master's Degree (Post Graduate MA/MSc.) in Economics/ Statistics/ Data Science/ Finance/ from any recognized university.
- Advanced quantitative and econometrics skills, data management abilities and knowledge of Stata and Excel are essential. Working knowledge of R, Matlab, and/or Python for econometrics and/or economic modelling applications is desirable.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills in English. Knowledge of MS Word, Excel
 and PowerPoint are essential and that of LaTeX, Scientific Workplace and/or Tableau is
 desirable.
- Candidates with exposure to domestic and international databases such as CMIE Prowess, Annual Survey of Industries, World Economic Outlook, World Development Indicators, etc. will be preferred.
- Prior relevant experience of 1-2 years is preferable, but not mandatory.

Job description: The incumbent will be required to support advanced empirical research and provide required research support to the RBI Chair Professor on tax, fiscal, macro-financial, capital flows and remittance matters.

The indicative areas of work under supervision of RBI Chair Professor or other persons designated by him will include but not be limited to the following:

- Preparing preliminary literature reviews and surveys of literature with appropriate bibliographical references and compilation of relevant papers or their extracts.
- Managing large macro, micro and panel databases by compiling, cleaning, parsing, duplicates removal, gap filling etc. for eventual econometric estimates.
- Exploring and suggesting preliminary econometric analysis or economic modelling frameworks appropriate to the research questions.
- Preparing Stata 'do' files or other such programs for data handling, economic modelling and econometric estimation.
- Preparing charts, tables, figures, presentations etc. in Excel, Stata and/or PowerPoint
- Assist in preparing draft research papers, policy notes and reports.
- Performing such other duties as assigned from time to time by RBI Chair Professor or other persons designated by him.
